

Art Room Expectations

Welcome to the Art room! Please familiarize and abide by the following expectations in the art room.

1. Clean up after yourself:

- Participation points will be dropped if you do not clean up after yourself.
- If messy behavior continues restitution will be given.
- Please leave your area clean after you have used it, including wiping the table and putting away supplies.
- Store artwork in the drawers or your portfolio

2.. No self doubt allowed:

- Be teachable! All we need is a teachable attitude and I can help you learn new skills in art.
- If you have experience, push yourself. Explore new things, be more creative, combine ideas. You will be required to push yourself according to whether you are in Art I, II, studio or AP art.

3. Present your work:

- Art work needs to be displayed. You will learn how to mount your work

4. Explain your work:

- Each artwork will need a typed out explanation and label.

5. Keep your work:

- Do not throw unsuccessful work away. (You can learn from that too)
- Make and maintain your portfolio

6. Learn from other artists:

- Learn and look at your peer's work. Encourage others
- Discover Artists from different times. Choose an artist from a different time period. One assignment will be to write about him/her.

7. Safety:

- You are responsible for the supplies you have checked out. Please do not leave them on the table or hand them to another student. At the end of the period, please check them back into Rachel. Supplies must NOT leave the classroom, this includes wet clay.
- Safety is one of the biggest focus' of the art room.
- No students are allowed in the art room unattended

8. Computer Use:

- The same rules apply to these computers as in the Computer lab.
- No access to computers or the internet without teacher present
- No Social media sites including YouTube. On occasion YouTube and Flickr will be allowed but only with teacher present
- Do not access shared docs from these computers
- Do not change backgrounds or computer settings

9. Music:

- Only Rachel's Pandora account can be accessed and listened to. No GrooveShark or personal Pandora accounts.

10. Appropriateness:

- No drawing of nudity or provocative images, no violence including guns or graphic images, no drug or gang references including tagging, no references to smoking or alcohol, or racist images.
