

HOW DO I GET AN A IN ART?

Each quarter you will create 4 assignments each worth 100 points. Each work should show 2 weeks or approximately 10 hours of work in class. If you choose to work further on an art project, it can be worth 2 projects, or 200 points which is equal to 20 hours of work.

Please refer to the grading sheet. First, you will grade yourself. Second, the teacher will grade you. Usually, those grades are very similar if you have not been too critical or self assured.

25 points are given for **Creativity**

- Did you think of a creative idea? Or just copy from a photograph?
- Did you combine ideas or photographs into one great artwork?
- Does your art have a creative theme or meaning?
- Is your idea new or copied?

25 points are given for **Craftsmanship**

- Is your work neat and tidy?
- Would you be proud of it to be hung up around the school for others to see?
- Is the paper crisp rather than crumpled and torn?
- Is there any canvas/clay unpainted?
- Did you take time or rush?
- Did you take the time to erase unneeded pencil marks?

25 points are given for **Technique and Skill**

- Did you advance in your artistic skills while doing this project?
- Did you do your best to apply the techniques you have learned?
- Did you use the medium correctly?

25 points are given for **Following instructions**

- Did you learn something new?
- Did you allow Rachel to teach you new techniques?
- Did you apply the principles she taught you?

TOTAL = 100 POINTS
